## Minutes – July 28, 2023

## Brand Room/Rendezvous Center

CALL TO ORDER: President Lee Hageman called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

- b. It was decided on and voted on to Enthusiastically celebrate Constitution Week (September 17-23): Radio Ads promoting Constitution Week at the cost of @\$350 will be split with the GCRP. A banner for Goshen County Republican Women will be purchased in the amount of \$75.00. A banner advertising "Celebrate Constitution Week" will be purchased in the amount of \$28.00. 100 Pocket Constitutions will be purchased in the amount of \$98.52. To celebrate Constitution Week, it was also decided to set up a table on Main Street (mid-week) the week prior for a couple of hours to promote CW

- and to hand out pocket Constitutions. Also, to do the same at the Thursday's Farmer's Market. Susan Dovey volunteered to head up this committee.
- c. The members were encouraged to write Letters to the Editor promoting Constitution Week.
- d. The Annual Meeting will be held in October with the purpose of: Electing Officers, Collecting Dues, Receiving an Audit Report and selecting a delegate to the State NFRW Conference to be held in Casper on October 26<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>. Pat Ellis and Pat Buckhaults were elected as the Nominating Committee for Officer Elections. Susan Dovey and Lynda Baumgardner were appointed as the Audit Committee to audit the Treasurer's books as required by our bylaws every two years.
